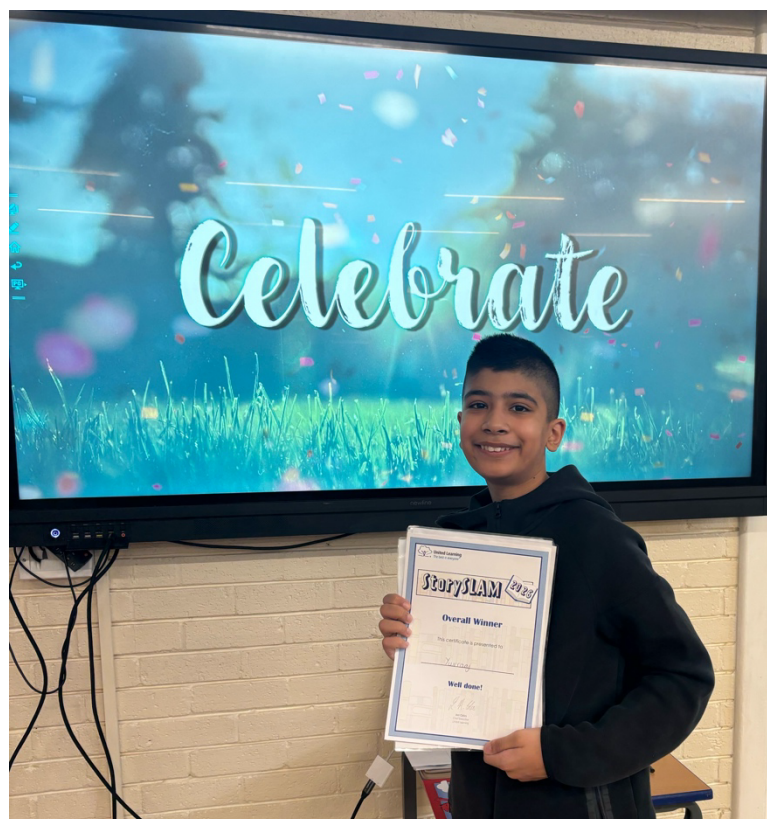

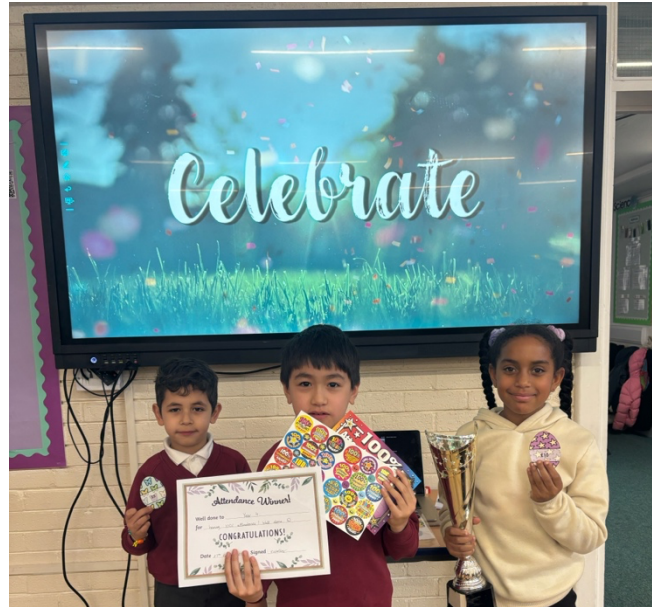

Throughout the year we provide help with clothes, toys, baby equipment, bedding and toiletries for your children.



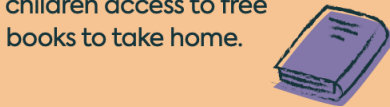
Smart Start
