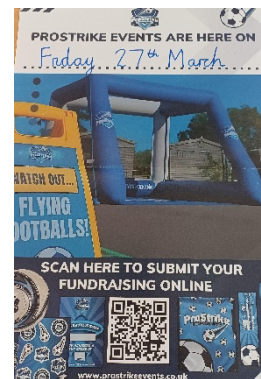


Updates

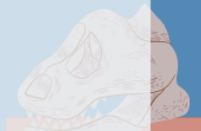
