In Nursery we enjoy Maths activities every day. We would like you to choose at least one of the following activities to complete at home. Go on a number hunt! What numbers can you see around your house or on your way to school?

Use building bricks to measure some of your toys. How many bricks high are they? Can you make a tower of 10 bricks? How tall can you make a tower before it falls over? Count each brick as you add it on.

In a shallow tray or plate of flour or sand, use your finger to write a numeral from 0 to 10.

Maths

Practise counting out objects, such as buttons, toys or sticks collected on a walk. Encourage your child to point to each object as they say the number name.

Go on a shape hunt around your house. See if you can find circles, squares, rectangles or triangles.

Measure ingredients and bake something yummy together and set the timer for it to cook.
